The kids had a positive response to the new Marching Wildcat food procedures for HOME games. Everyone agreed it helped the kids maximize their time! We have another HOME game Friday 10/6. Here are the details again:

If your Marching Wildcat would like to eat at HOME football games he/she MUST PREPAY for their Wildcat Dinner Combo. Payments will be accepted on Wednesday and Thursday after marching practice during the week of the home game. The cost of the Combo is \$5 (cash or check payable to GBBPA) and includes a hamburger, cheeseburger OR hot dog, chips and water bottle. At the game on Friday, a table will be set up near the South Concession stand with the student's meal ready for a quick pick up. (This ONLY applies to HOME games, NOT AWAY games.)



Wildcat Dollars! We are very excited that some students are using their Wildcat Dollars to pay for small things like gloves and music. When used, the Treasurer receives notice and the Wildcat Dollar amount is subtracted from the student's CHARMS account. If Wildcat Dollars are not available on the student's account, the Treasurer will then send out a bill for the remainder of the money due. Scrip Tips of the Week:



- The rebate from your first on-line Scrip order is counted as 100% Wildcat dollars for your student.
- After placing 5 on-line Scrip orders of \$200 or more, your 6th online Scrip order is 100% Wildcat dollars.
- All orders placed within a day count as one order.
- We split almost all other rebates 50/50 with the band and the student's Wildcat dollar account.

Parents have paid their child's full band fees with the money they earned in Scrip. It's the best fundraiser ever because it's "free money". You don't have to sell anything AND you support the band!

Check out all of the retailers on shopwithscrip.com. You just buy gift cards and use them. There are over 700 retailers who participate!

How do I order Scrip? Go to shopwithscrip.com. Create a family account. You will need the enrollment code: 69677AL212856. This code links your family account to the band. Simply place your order. Then an email is sent to me letting me know there is a pending order. Easy!

Don't forget that Scrip orders are due on the first and third Fridays of the month which means the next deadline is this Friday, October 6th. The orders should be in by the following Friday. We also have Scrip in inventory. You don't have to wait!

- 1:00 PM** Room Open – Guard Tardy Time for stretching - Chaperones Report
- 1:30 PM** Tardy Time - have your 2017 Marching Wildcats T-shirt, bibbers, Dinkles, gloves and black socks on. Garment bag (Jacket, Sash, Gauntlets) will remain on the rack until after we rehearse. You will put them on before we depart for the Sportsplex. Please eat a meal before you get to the school and bring a light snack to eat after rehearsal. - Chaperones Monitor
- 2:00 PM** Arrive at GBMS, unload and rehearsal at the stadium - Chaperones Monitor
- 4:45 PM** Depart GBMS for the Sports Plex - Chaperones Monitor
- 5:15 PM** Arrival, unload and line up for warm ups - Chaperones Monitor
- 7:45 PM** Marching Wildcats performance Time - Chaperones Monitor
- 10:20 PM** Announcement of Awards (Drum Majors & Section leaders keep Shakos and Plumes with you) -Load trailers & buses - Do not change out of uniform until we arrive back at GBHS!!! - Chaperones Monitor
- 11:00 PM** Arrive GBHS - NEATLY put uniforms and any equipment away. Leadership must check each student's uniform before they can leave. - Chaperones Monitor
